For Hearing Families with DHH Children ages 2-5

Time commitment: Up to 6 hours

- Two or more 30-minute language task blocks (up to 3 for adults, up to 3 for children)
- Adult alone
- Adult and researcher
- Adult and child
- Child and researcher

Thank you payment: \$10 per half-hour

For Hearing Families with DHH Children ages 2-3

Time commitment: 1 year

- One year of periodic ASL services
- Weekly 30-minute play sessions with your child
- Tablet for recording, toys, and books will be provided
- Six sets of language tasks

Thank you payment: Up to \$50 per month
